


Use of the Gym and Swimming Pools

All teams **ARE REQUIRED** to stay in the competition hotel, Village Hotel Sentosa, Singapore and arrive no later than **Friday 8th September 2023** and depart no earlier than **Friday 15th September 2023**. This is a 7-night minimum stay. This requirement is conditional for us to secure a block rate for rooms and function space which would otherwise be expensive before a Formula 1® Grand Prix.

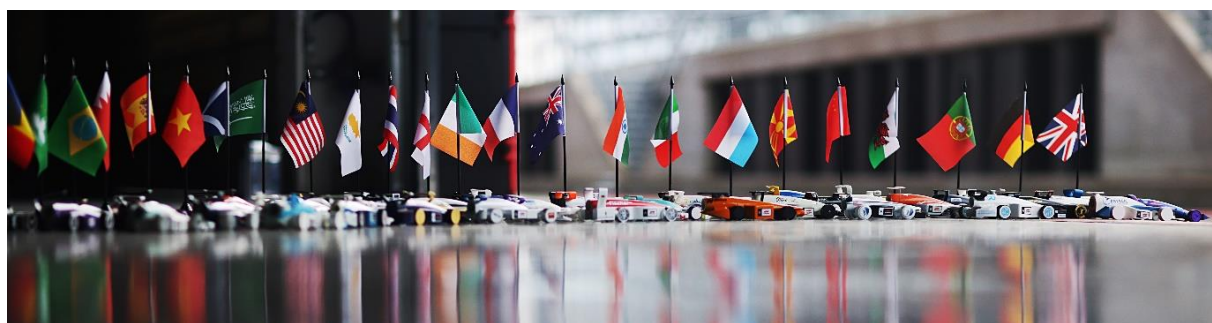
The room rates increase significantly on **Thursday 14th September**; therefore, we have averaged the room rate across the 7-night stay which takes into account the higher nightly rate on Thursday.

Please note hotel rates below are presented in Singapore Dollars SGD

* F1 in Schools HQ recommends the family room for 3 guests. The Family room has 1 king bed and two single beds with two vanities and bathrooms. The Family room can accommodate 4 guests if the king bed is shared but this decision and responsibility lie solely on lead adults / school and parents.

OFFICIAL TEAM REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES:



WORLD FINALS ENTRY FEE

All teams will be required to pay an entry fee to the World Finals. This will be paid via an individual participation fee of **GBP 750.00 PER PERSON**. All official team members, accompanying adults, affiliated students and team guests will be required to pay this and it will include:

- Official Team Entry Fee to the Aramco 2023 F1 in Schools World Finals
- Lunch and refreshment breaks during the competition days (Sunday, Monday & Tuesday)
- Awards Celebration Gala Dinner on (Wednesday)
- Transportation to all official activities outside of the competition hotel
- Social activity including:
 - Exclusive visit to the Singapore Marina Bay Circuit for a Pit Lane Walk (Thursday)
 - Entry to the Official After Party (Thursday Evening)

To secure an entry to the World Finals, teams will be required to pay a non-refundable registration fee of 30% of their official team members total participation fees. The below table shows how this will be calculated.

- We require all teams to travel with at least 2 accompanying adults, one of whom will assume the Lead Adult title. This is a child safeguarding requirement for a scenario where one adult is taken ill or incapacitated leaving the second adult to take full responsibility for the students.
- Registration will be a two-part process as detailed below (Initial and Final Registration).
- The 30% Initial Registration fee will be non-refundable and will be invoiced after the Initial Registration and will be payable within 30 days of invoice date.
- The 70% balance payment will be invoiced following the Final Registration and will be due for payment on **Friday 11th of August 2023**.
- Team participation fees will be invoiced by F1 in Schools LTD and will be charged in British Pounds Sterling GBP.
- If a country has not selected their teams via a National Final event before the Initial Registration closes, the ICC may register a place for their teams and pay the minimum (non-refundable) registration fee of GBP 1,125 to secure the entry.
- Payment will be possible by credit/debit card or bank transfer (credit card fees may apply). If you are planning to pay by wired / electronic transfer, funds need to be cleared in the F1 in Schools bank account before the payment deadline.
- Please note that both local and overseas bank charges will be the responsibility of the remitter.

INITIAL TEAM REGISTRATION

Teams are initially asked to complete registration at the below link. This will ask for the team's name, country, number of official team members, accompanying adults, affiliated students and team guests. Hotel accommodation requirements will also be requested. The Initial Registration must be completed by **Friday 10th March 2023** and the **30% Registration Fee payment** must be received by F1 in Schools LTD 30 days after the invoice date. Once this payment has been received, the team is considered registered for the 2023 World Finals.

Important: If the team decides to withdraw after Initial registration, the registration payment will not be refunded.

The registration website is a secure site and operates within data protection laws. Data requested will only be used in relation to and used for the F1 in Schools World Finals.

FINAL TEAM REGISTRATION

Teams will then be asked to complete the full registration link which will detail full team information. All participants will be asked to submit a photograph for their event accreditation. This registration will open on **Thursday 06th of April 2023** and must be completed by **Friday 12th of May 2023**. The **70% balance payment** is to be received by 1 month prior to the start of the event – **Friday 11th of August 2023**. Registration link will be sent in an upcoming official event newsletter.

HOTEL BOOKING AND PAYMENT

Please ensure you read the below information carefully and take note of the payment process and deadlines. Hotel booking will open on **Thursday 06th of April 2023**.

- **The daily hotel rates shown are in Singapore Dollars (SGD), however, you will be charged in US Dollars (USD). The full invoice amount will be converted into USD on the day of invoicing at the prevailing exchange rate on the day.**
- All quoted room rates are inclusive of Singapore Government tax and service fees.
- Formula 1® World Travel will be handling all event hotel bookings. They have a wealth of experience and coordinate all Formula 1 Management travel.
- Following the Initial Team Registration, the Formula 1® World Travel booking URL will be shared with the nominated Lead Adult and Team Manager.
- The personal information submitted during the Initial Registration will be shared with Formula 1® World Travel solely for the purpose of facilitating your hotel booking.
- You will be asked to acknowledge this on the registration form on behalf of your group and we require this information to have been disseminated to your party before your acknowledgement.
- All hotel room bookings must be made by **Friday 19th May 2023** and will be invoiced by Formula 1® World Travel and be paid by **Friday 26th May 2023**.
- Payment will be possible by credit/debit card or bank transfer (credit card fees may apply).
- All credit card transactions and electronic transfers are made direct with Formula 1® World Travel.

- If you are planning to pay by wired / electronic transfer, funds need to be cleared in the Formula 1® World Travel’s bank account before 5pm GMT on the payment deadline date.
- If payment is not made by the payment deadline, the bookings will be charged at the hotel rate card which will be significantly higher and will not include the negotiated extras. We cannot make any exceptions to this so please plan your payment well in advance.
- Formula 1® World Travel - Hotel Terms & Conditions
 1. Once bookings are made, 100% cancellation charges apply.
 2. Prior to confirmation, hotel rates and availability are subject to change.
 3. In the event of a fluctuation in the rate of exchange Formula 1® World Travel reserves the right to advise clients and amend the quoted rate prior to invoicing.
 4. All extras/incidentals are to be paid for by the client direct to the hotel upon departure.

ADDITIONAL HOTEL INFORMATION

- There are a limited number of inter linking family rooms. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
- Rooms are guaranteed for official team members, accompanying adults and affiliated students. We are able to extend our hotel rates to judges, team guests, parents and guardians, however, if we are approaching our room quota, priority will be given to our official participants. Teams will be notified in advance if this affects their booking.
- All rates include a daily buffet breakfast within the hotel, tea/coffee facilities in the hotel room and complimentary internet access.
- 20% discount on all laundry and dry-cleaning services.
- All extras/incidentals are to be paid for by the guest direct to the hotel upon departure. **A credit card will be required on check-in** for room extras/incidentals.
- Check-in - although the hotel’s official check-in time is at 3pm, it may not always be possible to have all group rooms ready by that time. In order to maximise the efficiency of check-in, the hotel needs a detailed arrival schedule, we require all teams to supply flight details and estimated hotel arrival time to us via email to world@f1inschools.com as soon as you have your flights confirmed. We will then issue this to the hotel.
- If guaranteed rooms are required prior to 3pm, they should be reserved from the previous night; however, the hotel will make every attempt to have the rooms ready for arriving guests.
- The check-out time is at 12pm (midday).

FORMULA 1® SINGAPORE AIRLINES SINGAPORE GRAND PRIX 2023

The 2023 Formula 1 Singapore Grand Prix will take place between the 15th and 17th September 2023. Although staying in Singapore for the F1 Grand Prix is optional, we do recommend that every effort is made to stay for one of the most impressive and exciting Formula 1® races of the season.

More information about the Singapore Grand Prix can be found at www.singaporegp.sg where you will also find information about the 2023 concerts and entertainment.

We have secured a discounted rate with the race promotor and also have a small number of rooms on hold at the competition hotel. If you are planning to stay for the race weekend please could you advise us by email to world@f1inschools.com. We will then send further details about GP ticket and hotel options.

WORLD CHAMPIONS

IMPORTANT - If your team is crowned World Champions, please be prepared for 2 full days of media activity at Singapore Marina Bay Circuit on Thursday 14th and Friday 15th September. The team will be taken into the F1® paddock to meet with Stefano Domenicali, various Formula 1® teams and our partners.

PIT DISPLAYS



We are back to Pit displays being physically judged with judging teams visiting the teams' allocated spaces. This space will also be the teams base for the event. We actively encourage teams to engage with visitors and VIPs within this area. Each team will be provided with a shell scheme booth of 3m x 1m which will contain a power socket, a table and team header board. Full details of the booth structure will be available asap.

As part of our sustainability objectives, **teams will no longer be able to send pit displays as freight to any future World Finals including the 2023 event.** If your team attempts to freight anything to the venue, **we will refuse delivery.**

Our objective is to deliver a sustainable event and align with the [Formula 1 Net Zero Carbon 2030 and their goal of zero waste](#) . You should think about how to build a display that can be easily transported and

reused at your school to help us promote F1 in Schools. Please remember that there are points available regarding sustainability in competition scorecards.

More information to be included in the Competition Regulations, basic instructions are below:

- All pit display materials must be hand carried, by the team, into the World Finals event venue.
- There will be **NO option to have freight delivered to the event venue.**
- All pit display materials must be hand carried and we recommend that the dimensions would be acceptable by an airline for checked baggage into the hold of an aircraft.
- All materials brought into the venue must be taken away at the end of the event.
- There will be no waste (rubbish) disposal options during pit build and breakdown.
- Your pit display area must be left as you found it.

Please note:

- Production companies will not be allowed to assist teams on the transportation or assembly of pit displays.
- There will be a 2 hours' time limit to set up the pit displays.
- Point penalties can be given at the discretion of the Chair of Judges if any of the above instructions are not followed.

PROJECT ELEMENT SUBMISSION DEADLINES

Teams will be required to submit in advance the main competition project elements:

- Design and Engineering Portfolio
- Enterprise Portfolio
- Project Management Portfolio

Detailed Information about digital and physical project element submission will be released in the Aramco F1 in Schools World Finals Competition Regulations 2023 to be released in the upcoming weeks.

VISA TO ENTER SINGAPORE

We will be issuing all teams with a formal invitation for VISA applications. Please contact your local embassy to request information about VISA requirements for entry to Singapore. In particular asking how long it can take to process entry visas.

COVID 19

This event is being held in Singapore. Singapore has now lifted all Covid 19 restrictions and laws so the event will continue in a normal way. We will follow any Singapore Government processes should this become necessary.

At the time of writing, there are currently some entry requirements that you may need to follow to enter Singapore. This information will be updated on the Singapore Government website [here](#).
